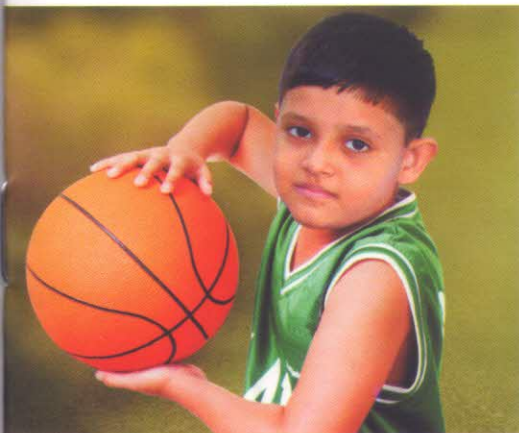

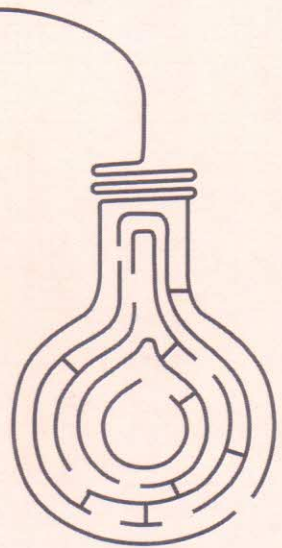

A Secure Campus :

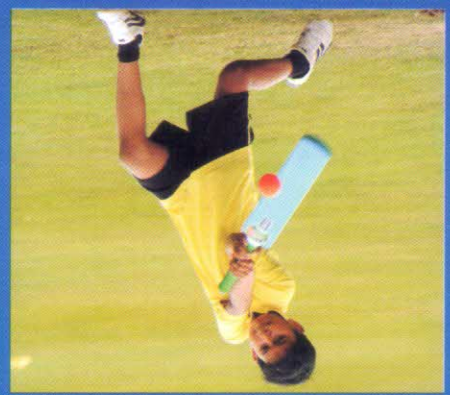
We have 24*7 secure campus, backed by able fleet of security guards, CCTV cameras, fenced walls which provide complete security to our students.

This is a critical stage in the life and times of the student .Therefore we at DIS take extra care to ensure that the student remains focused on his or her end objective- of achieving excellence in any field they so desire.

TECHNICAL DETAILS ABOUT DOON

Examinations

Examinations may not be a true test of child's ability, but regular classroom tests and periodic examinations at the school level are indicative of scholastic achievement. The results enable class teachers as well as students to reassess their orientation and take corrective steps to accord due attention to subjects and topics in which the child may not have been found up to the expectations. Apart from monthly tests, results of which are also intimated to the parents, examinations are organized as per the following schedule:

Formative Assessment I	: Last week of April/ Mid June
Formative Assessment II	: Last week of July
Summative Assessment I	: Mid September
Formative Assessment III	: First week of November
Formative Assessment IV	: mid January
Summative Assessment II	: Mid March

Examinations go from nominal to critical levels-- students' progress in their studies is graded and monitored in this manner, with periodic reports of the same sent to students' wards. **Admission procedure** Parents and or guardians need to register their children/wards on Application/Registration form enclosed with this prospectus. All the requirements mentioned in the Application/Registration form should be strictly adhered to. Admission is purely on the basis of Merit list prepared after the entrance test/personal interview wherever applicable and provided there is a seat vacant. After the child has qualified in the interview and admission has been confirmed, the parents should immediately deposit the necessary fees as per the fee structure enclosed, failing which the offer of admission may be communicated to the next eligible candidate. The age limit for various classes has been specified in the following table :

The Admission form must be accompanied by the documents listed below:

- i. Mark sheet of the last session attended in any school.
- ii. Transfer Certificate in original (after confirmation of admission)

- iii. Conduct certificate
- iv. Migration Certificate (needed only for some courses)
- v. Copy of Birth Certificate attested by an appropriate authority
- vi. Medical fitness certificate

Direct Admission:

The school may offer direct admission to meritorious students both Indian/Overseas based on their academic records in their current school. For direct admission, applicants must enclose the last two years report cards, progress report and a teacher's recommendation along with the application for admission.

Important Tips

The school takes the responsibility to inform the Parents/Guardians about the ward's academics, health, or behavior and conduct at regular

intervals. The school authorities are at full discretion to suspend/terminate the child from the school on disciplinary or academic grounds. Possession of cash/valuables, jewelry, mobile phones or any other electronic item is strictly prohibited. In case the child is caught keeping any prohibited articles, it shall be confiscated and given for charity. Parents are requested not to oblige any staff member, teaching or non-teaching by giving gifts in cash or kind. Punctuality in reporting the child in time to school after vacation must be strictly adhered to, failing which a fine of Rs 500/- per day shall be levied.

The school has a well-equipped library, so no books except books on general awareness and course books are permitted. Wholesome, nourishing veg and non-veg food is provided, hence parents are requested not to give extra tiffin to their children. Request for additional help for any subject must be given in writing to the Academic Coordinator of the school. Phone calls to students are allowed only on Sundays or holidays. No child shall be permitted to meet visitors during school hours/ working days unless prior permission of the principal has been taken.

Health Tips

All students must submit a certificate of fitness awarded by a consultant physician, which should include important laboratory investigations, the report being awarded by a qualified D.C.P or M.D.(Pathology).

The Medical Certificate should confirm that the child has not been in contact with any contagious disease within three weeks prior to joining school. All students must also get a clearance certificate from a dentist (B.D.S or M.D.S.) and if the ward has dental problems, the same must be corrected before the student reports back.

Students must get a thorough optical check up done by an Ophthalmologist and if spectacles are prescribed, the same may be obtained before the ward is admitted to the school. The parents may ensure that the ward is vaccinated as per schedule recommended by WHO. If for any reason, the ward is not vaccinated for the same, the fact must be brought to the notice of the school authorities, so

that arrangement may be made for the vaccination without delay. Primary vaccinations and status of Boosters must also be intimated.

Parents will be required to withdraw a child who is a bed wetter. Students who are under any prolonged line of treatment, must bring along a detailed summary and prescription by the treating doctor, enabling the school doctor to take charge of the same. No medicines or tonics may be handed over to the students directly, as it may pose a hazard to others.

The parents/guardians are hereby understood to have agreed not to have any objection to their child/ward being offered emergency help of surgery- as may be advised by the concerned doctor. Medicines, medical certificates, reports, prescription, are to be handed over to the Matron or sister-in-charge of the dispensary. The children are weighed regularly, and the diet is constantly reviewed, inspected and revised.

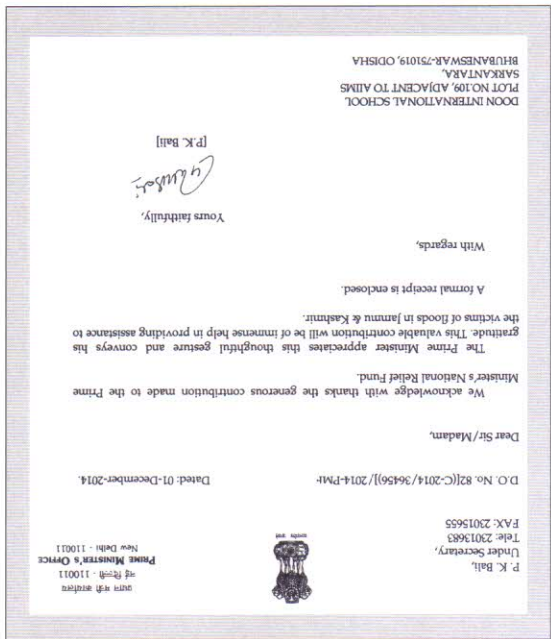
Fee Regulations

Fees for the first year is payable in advance and from the second year may be paid in two installments. Statement of Dues is issued towards the end of September and March and is to be honoured within 15 days of receipt of bills, failing which late fee is levied. Recurring expenses borne by the child on items not covered in the Fee Schedule attached, will be an additional cost to the students.

Fees are charged from the 1st April whether the students join on the date or not. Fees are payable for the entire year irrespective of the fact that a student stayed or studied in the school/ school hostel for a part of the session. Please counsel and prepare your ward before making him/her join the hostel so that he/she is not tenuous in his/her adjustment in the hostel.

As the availability of the seats is limited, the school shall not refund the fees in case of any withdrawal in mid-session. Late comers shall be fined an amount of Rs 500/- per day. Students will not be allowed to return to school after the vacations, unless the accounts for previous school term have been settled in full. No reduction is allowed for broken periods. All dues must be cleared before the child leaves the school. The school reserves the right to initiate legal action to recover outstanding dues, from parents who withdraw their child from school without clearing

Doon Social Responsibilities :

him/her accordingly and no one else will be allocated that accommodation under any circumstances. In such an event, the parents will be liable to pay for the entire next school term even if the child does not attend the school. Applications for refund of Caution Money must reach the school office not later than 31st December of the year in which the child last attended the school. The same shall be processed and cheque for refunds will reach the parents within 3 months.

Withdrawals :

Permissions to attend special functions at home shall not be usually granted, as a safeguard both for health and study. Parents may visit or take their children out, for a maximum of two outings a month on Sundays and Holidays only. Children must return to school latest by 6:00pm. Besides parents, no other relatives will be permitted to take the child out for the night. Parents are requested to discourage frequent visits and outings, as the child will then take very long time to settle down and concentrate on his/her studies. When permitted to go out, children must be accompanied by their parents or by some duly authorized person. On their return they must report to the Matron/House Master. No student will be allowed out with friends or relatives unless a written permission from the parents is available. Letters of authorization should be written on official letter head paper with complete details. No child will be allowed to go out with a brother or sister studying in other schools.

General Regulations :

outstanding payments. All disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of Bhubaneswar courts only.

regulations. No withdrawals are ordinarily permitted during mid-session, except in special circumstances and are convincing to the management of the school. No refunds will be allowed, nor deductions made in fees and dues payable as per fee regulations. Three months advance notice in writing shall be required if a parent wishes not to send the child for the following session. Ordinarily, such notices should reach the school not later than 31st December of the year preceding that in which the child is sought to be withdrawn. It will be assumed that the parent has given consent for the enrolment of the child for the next year and accommodation will be reserved for
